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## We are no longer under the law but under grace?

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Let us discern the true meaning of this.

1. Deuteronomy 31:24-26 And it came to pass, when Moses had made an end of writing the words of this law in a book, until they were finished,  
<sup>25</sup> That Moses commanded the Levites, which bare the ark of the covenant of the LORD, saying,  
<sup>26</sup> Take this book of the law, and put it in the side of the ark of the covenant of the LORD your God, that it may be there for a witness against thee.

Moses wrote this law in a book and put it in the side of, the Ark of the Covenant.

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This book that Moses wrote in contained 616 laws of curses for breaking of the 10 commandments.

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## **God wrote the law of 10 commandments with His own finger on tables of stone.**

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Exodus 31:18 <sup>18</sup> And he gave unto Moses, when he had made an end of communing with him upon mount Sinai, two tables of testimony, tables of stone, written with the finger of God.

**Deuteronomy 10:1-5 10 At that time the LORD said unto me, Hew thee two tables of stone like unto the first, and come up unto me into the mount, and make thee an ark of wood.**

**1. <sup>2</sup> And I will write on the tables the words that were in the first tables which thou brakest, and thou shalt put them in the ark.** (Put them in the ark.)

Moses broke the tables with the 10 commandments that were written by the very finger of God, and he had to return and have God write them again because Moses broke the first set when he saw the Israelites worshipping a golden calf.

If the 10 commandments were one and the same as the book that Moses wrote the law in then why was there need to re-write the 10 commandments? Because if they were all part of the one law then they would be in the book but they were not and were written again on stone tablets and put into the ark.

The law that God gave Moses to write and put in a book were the statutes of the law that fulfilled the sacrificial requirements for breaking of the 10 commandments. Just as

in our judicial system there are statutes of the law that outline the punishments for violation of the law.

1 kings 6:13 <sup>12</sup>Concerning this house which thou art in building, if thou wilt walk in my statutes, and execute my judgments, and keep all my commandments to walk in them; then will I perform my word with thee, which I spake unto David thy father:

In other words the law that God gave Moses to write in a book were the statutes of the law of the 10 commandments which are the punishments fitting to judgements and requirements of a restitution, repayment process for breaking of the law.

Today we may be sentenced to death if we commit murder which is still practiced in some states of the USA. Depending on the nature of the crime we can pay a heavy fine right down to requirement to do jail time or community service for our lawless actions and this will suffice the judge for payment of the crime committed. Our Christian nations operate on the same statutes of requirement for the breaking of the law.

YHWH set down the exact requirements and the legislation of the law, and every detail of the law was set out in detail fitting to the crime committed. These statutes and laws are recorded in Leviticus and Deuteronomy.

This was given to Moses and written in a book of which further laws and statutes were recorded as the nation of Israel developed and its need for further punishment to fit the crimes.

King David was given laws pertaining Israel forbidden to take plural wives and this was written in a book and given to the priests to read and teach throughout their generations. Deuteronomy 17:17-19. Neither shall he multiply wives to himself, that his heart turn not away: neither shall he greatly multiply to himself silver and gold.

<sup>18</sup> And it shall be, when he sitteth upon the throne of his kingdom, that he shall write him a copy of this law in a book out of that which is before the priests the Levites:

<sup>19</sup> And it shall be with him, and he shall read therein all the days of his life: that he may learn to fear the LORD his God, to keep all the words of this law and these statutes, to do them:

The whole chapter in Deuteronomy 17 needs to be read to see that those who did not adhere to the laws and pay for their crimes were to be put to death. The payment for the breaking of the 10 commandments were, your own life if you took a life, committed adultery and lesser crimes would require the blood sacrifice of a bull or sheep or goat depending on the crime.



Many times the person who committed the crime had to work without pay for the person they had inflicted or stolen from and were subject to their rule over them until they paid the full debt which was 6 years of servitude and then on the 7<sup>th</sup> year released with food provision and stock or even a house so that they may be able to support themselves.

YHWH set out a very detailed and comprehensive book of statutes of the law which required a sacrifice for the sin committed and this is the law that Yahshua fulfilled.

The statutes of the law. The law given to Moses and written in a book.

*Deuteronomy 6:1-9* “Now this is the commandment—the statutes and the rules—that the Lord your God commanded me to teach you, that you may do them in the land to which you are going over, to possess it, that you may fear the Lord your God, you and your son and your son’s son, by keeping

*all his statutes and his commandments, which I command you, all the days of your life, and that your days may be long. Hear therefore, O Israel, and be careful to do them, that it may go well with you, and that you may multiply greatly, as the Lord, the God of your fathers, has promised you, in a land flowing with milk and honey. “Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one. You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might. And these words that I command you today shall be on your heart. You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise. You shall bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates.*

*Statutes and commandments are separated in the above scripture to show that one is the law of commandments and the other is the statute law pertaining to breaking of the commandments.*

Matthew 5:17 Think not that I am come to destroy the law, or the prophets: I am not come to destroy, but to fulfil.

We more than ever, need to be versed and have a deep knowledge of biblical truths, if we are to survive the coming events of the last days.

**Yahshua told us He did not come to destroy the law but to fulfill it. Matthew 5:17-20.**

<sup>17</sup> Think not that I am come to destroy the law, or the prophets: I am not come to destroy, but to fulfil.

<sup>18</sup> For verily I say unto you, Till heaven and earth pass, one jot or one tittle shall in no wise pass from the law, till all be fulfilled.

He came to fulfill the sacrificial requirements and became the ultimate sacrifice for us as our Passover Lamb. Then He says, But, in this verse He also said I have come to bring about, bring to fruition, come to deliver, come to satisfy the requirements of. So, if we examine the whole verse and put it into the correct context, then we can see that Yahshua did not come to abolish the law, but to consummate it and bring it to fullness; He has delivered it, to us, for us, for-ever. He stood in as our Passover Lamb and has now consummated our relationship with Him. We must realise that the whole story from Genesis to Revelation is the greatest love story ever told.

**Matthew 5:19** Whosoever therefore shall break one of these least commandments, and shall teach men so, he shall be called the least in the kingdom of heaven: but whosoever shall do and teach them, the same shall be called great in the kingdom of heaven.

Yahshua's love for His bride. In essence, the scripture is saying this; I have not come to abolish, but to take the ritual of the law and fulfill that and to bring a superior law that is a consummation of the marriage contract with the bride. If we

are to rightly divide the word of God, then we need to fully understand the meaning of the words used and the deeper meaning implied behind the words. Yahshua, is telling us in Matthew 5:17 He died for us and it is His supreme, faultless, superior, sacrifice for and on behalf of His bride, to consummate His covenant with us. Those who simply say, “Oh good, He abolished the law and now we no longer have to obey the ten commandments we just need to believe in His name, and we are saved.” How far from the truth this is.

That is a reckless way to read and is for those who want it all and have nothing to do, but just take the benefits without the commitment to the covenant. In other words, they will take the good but are not interested in the obligation. If we keep reading in Matthew 5:17- 20 For verily I say unto you, Till heaven and earth pass, one jot or one tittle shall in no wise pass from the law, till all be fulfilled.

Till all be fulfilled.

This indicates that He has fulfilled part of the law which entails the sacrificial requirements, but not all of the law. Till all be fulfilled shows us that all of His law must be fulfilled. We know that will not all be fulfilled until He comes in judgement, therefore by no means are we to think that we do not continue in His commandments, as HE points out in following verses.

Matthew 5:19 Whosoever therefore shall break one of these least commandments, and shall teach men so, he shall be called the least in the kingdom of heaven: but whosoever shall do and teach them, the same shall be called great in the kingdom of heaven. 20 For I say unto you, That except your

righteousness shall exceed the righteousness of the scribes and Pharisees, ye shall in no case enter into the kingdom of heaven.

What Christians need to do is realize the commitment they are undertaking when they take on them the name of Yahshua.

It is every bit the commitment they make to a spouse and very superior to this. Just as a wife takes on the husband's name, we are committing to Yahshua by taking His name upon us. He has given His blood for us on the cross. He died for His bride and resurrected, so that we may be His for eternity. Not just until death do us part, but an eternal marriage covenant. How long would our earthly marriage last if we were to take the attitude that our partner did it all and now we just have to know His name, so we can break the rules and expect that there will be no consequences for our actions?

Yahshua paid for the sin with His blood, but without sincere repentance then we are going to suffer the consequences of the sin. He did not take away the consequences of sin. If we sin we will suffer and die spiritually unless we repent and forsake the sin.

Matthew 22:35-40 Master, which is the great commandment in the law? 37 Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind.

Mark 12: 29 And Jesus answered him, the first of all the commandments is, Hear, O Israel; The Lord our God is one

Lord: The first commandment was, thou shalt have no other gods before me. Yahshua now tells us, He is God and we must love Him with our whole heart, mind and soul. 30 And thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all, thy mind, and with all thy strength: this is the first commandment.

Wow, did you hear that! Yahshua/Jesus, answered with,

HEAR O ISRAEL. So, for those saying the 10 commandments were only for Israel. Then why did Yahshua make a point of saying Hear O Israel in the New Testament, to the church?

If this is the new covenant and Yahshua is stating Hear O Israel when speaking to the church. He is telling the church His commandments stand for all Israel. All that have taken upon them His name is, immediately grafted into Israel. The Lord made no differentiation between physical Israel, the Jews, or spiritual Israel, the church and later again Paul confirms this in Galatians 3:28 There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither bond nor free, there is neither male nor female: for ye are all one in Christ Jesus. 29 And if ye be Christ's, then are ye Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise. THEN YE ARE ABRAHAM'S SEED ACCORDING TO THE PROMISE.

This is showing us that the church is, as much Israel as are the Jews. Church History. Then ye are Abraham's seed according to the promise.

Completely proving the misconception of those who divide the bible up and cut out the Old Testament, for Israel only.

The only part that was for Israel was the law of Moses, written in a book, for the Levitical priests to action this law, showing that it was temporary law of sacrifice of animals to pay for sin. Yahshua fulfilled this law, this is the law that is nailed to the cross, the book of the law given to Moses.

We are now are under Yahshua and He is the High Priest and we go directly to Him to confess our sins. He alone can forgive us because He paid the price for the sins we commit but He did not say keep sinning and I will just wipe it away. For example if you are tempted to have an affair in your marriage. Is that ok? Is that all covered for by Yahshua? No the consequence for this is spiritual death and a long and painful string of sins against you. Your partner's pain and children destroyed by this is not automatically washed away. You either, repent and repair the damage you have done or suffer the consequences of judgement.

Can you do this and repent later? Only when you have come to a full understanding of what you have done and felt the full remorse and made it up to those who you have hurt in the process, most times this can never be completely healed. But with remorseful repentance and sorrow for the sin then you are forgiven, but you still have to live with the consequences of the sin committed. This is something that could not have been possible to seek forgiveness without the atoning sacrifice that was made on your behalf.

A diabolical teaching that was first instituted by the Roman Catholic pagan religion, in the early centuries of the church, to take away from the bible, which we are instructed never to do and immediately put all born again Christians under a

false misconception and placing them outside of the covenant with God. Teaching that they are not Israel, therefore the Lords Feast days are only for Israel and not for Christians and then instituting the unbiblical exchange of the true sabbath to Sunday worship. Claiming we are under grace and not under the 10 commandments is a totally false concept.

Under grace means we were transferred from the mosaic sacrificial system of blood animal sacrifice to be under Yahshua and He is our judge and His judgement is made on your keeping of the 10 commandments. John 14:15 If you love me, keep my commandments.

Council of Nicaea. The First Council of Nicaea was a council of Christian bishops convened in the Bithynian city of Nicaea Bursa province, Turkey) by the Roman Emperor Constantine I in AD 325. Demolishing the Feast celebrations and observance and replacing them with Christmas and Easter, which are both non-biblical feasts and conveniently these substitute days of observance, fall on the same day as pagan sun-god worship for pagan gods. 25 December is the winter solstice and the observance behind this is that all of the known sun-deities were 'born' on December 25th, these include Mithra, Krishna (Vishnu), Osirit, Horus, Hercules, Dionysus (Bacchus), Tammuz, Indra, Buddha as well as the Scandinavian goddesses, (Aryan Sun Myths, The Origins of Religion – S.E. Titacombe), as well as all the other reincarnations of the child-god of Babylonian religious system. Behind all Pagan deity worship stands Satan himself. ## **The religions of the world are joining and aligning under the Roman Catholic religion.**

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May 14 2020. The Pope called a meeting of all religions of the world to unite and align under the Roman Church on the premises that they all worship the same god.

For that part is true. The religions of the world worship the false god and they have wide is the road for their belief.

Narrow is the road and all must find it and it is not ever going to be found in religious ideologies of this world.

The bible is the true word and when we live by its precepts we will find the true Mashiach and the only way and name under heaven by which we can be saved. Yahshua Ha Mashiach.

We must come out of the darkness of this world and into the light. The bible is the only true gospel on this earth. All Religions are man-made. We now more than ever, must be

versed and have a deep knowledge of biblical truths, if we are to survive the coming events of the last days.

Isaiah 45:3 And I will give thee the treasures of darkness, and hidden riches of secret places, that thou mayest know that I, the LORD, which call thee by thy name, am the God of Israel.

Ephesians 2:8-10 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: 9 Not of works, lest any man should boast. 10 For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them.

**Grace is ordained unto good works which we should walk in them. Walk in them means we walk in the commandments given us.**

Many Pastors are teaching us that there is no need for us to do anything because of this scripture, depicting grace as we are saved no matter what we do. We have seen that the law was not abolished, it was fulfilled. The law of Moses. (The sacrificial laws,) were fulfilled, consummated, in a marriage covenant with the church. There is no longer need for priests to sacrifice animals on our behalf for sin offerings.

Yahshua, has become our Passover Lamb and fulfilled this once and for all and is now our intercessor for -ever, with God.

If we were simply excused from all sin we would not require an intercessor with God.

We do not work our way through ritualistic sacrifices, we are saved through grace as we align our will to His.

Faith without works is dead, James 2:14-26. Which means we work at living as commanded but we do not do ritualistic animal sacrificial works of the law to be saved. Such is also the cults who do all kinds of ordinances claiming you cannot be saved without their works based rituals, or in other words without their religious ideologies. They completely deny the saving atoning sacrifice of Yahshua Ha Mashiach, teaching that their way is the way to salvation.

John 1:29 The next day John seeth Jesus coming unto him, and saith, Behold the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the world.

He paid the penalty for the sin, now we need to forsake the sin to be cleared of lawlessness.

Yahshua, has put us in an upgrade. So that we now can follow His law with a new sense of dignity, which means, we do not have to sacrifice an animal, to pay the price for our sin. It means we can now go to Yahshua, into His presence as a dignitary, and sit in the throne room and take our case before the King. WE now keep His commandments out of our love for Him, our new heart has desire only to love and serve our King.

Grace is not, a license to sin.

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Romans 7:7 What shall we say then? Is the law sin? God forbid. Nay, I had not known sin, but by the law: for I had not known lust, except the law had said, Thou shalt not covet.

Paul is quoting the tenth Commandment when he wrote this scripture, showing us that the Ten Commandments are very valid to us, which Yahshua also alluded to.

Matthew 5:28 But I say unto you, That whosoever looks on a woman to lust after her hath committed adultery with her already in his heart. If the Ten Commandments were abolished as many try to tell us, why then is Paul the apostle and Yahshua Himself using these commandments as examples for us.

He is not saying they are or will be abolished, in fact He is telling us that grace means, a whole higher level of behavior, where we are not only accountable for our sins but are judged also on our thoughts.

So, saved by grace brings about a higher meaning and observance. It is spiritual as well as physical, where once Israel were held accountable only for their actions, but now we the church, our thoughts will also condemn us. The difference between saved by the Law and saved by Grace.

In Israel, under the law came with the death penalty. Sin was judged and dealt with and those who broke the many laws of Moses, were shamed and seen covering themselves with sack cloth and ashes, trying to rid themselves and cleanse themselves from the terrible burden that sin brought on them. Imagine, if every time we sinned, we had to go and confess to the priests. Then we had to wait on the outcome of the trial that was held. If the sin was bad enough, we could find ourselves being stoned to death, or sacrificing animal blood to pay for our sin. Yet all these sacrifices were inadequate. They tried to lay the culprits guilt on a sheep or goat which

was killed – as though a scapegoat could really take away the guilt.

Under grace, the veil is taken down. There is no longer sacrifice of animals or standing before a panel of priests to decide your fate. Through grace we can go directly to Yahshua and confess our sins before Him. He has already paid the price for each and every one, of our sins, so that we don't have to take our best most precious animal and confess our sins to priests and offer the animal for sacrifice. All of that was done for us at the cross. Yahshua took our punishments, our stripes, as well as died for us, and resurrected to sit on the right hand of God as our, mediator and judge. So now we go to Him, our great High Priest and confess our sins directly to Him. All sin must be acknowledged and confessed before Him to receive a remission of them. Grace has lifted the burden of the law and given us direct access to God.

Yahshua is the High Priest who we must present to, at judgement. We need to go to Him to have our sins overturned and removed from the legal courts in heaven, so that we are clean and may enter His presence spotless before Him on judgement day.

The promise is, in the last remnant of time truth would be restored. But many will still reject the truth and will perish by the sword.

Jeremiah 6:16 Thus saith the LORD, Stand; ye in the ways, and see, and ask for the old paths, where is the good way, and walk therein, and ye shall find rest for your souls.

Isaiah 58:12-14 And they that shall be of thee shall build the old waste places: thou shalt raise up the foundations of many generations; and thou shalt be called, The repairer of the breach, The restorer of paths to dwell in. 13 If thou turn away thy foot from the sabbath, from doing thy pleasure on my holy day; and call the sabbath a delight, the holy of the LORD, honorable; and shalt honor him, not doing thine own ways, nor finding thine own pleasure, nor speaking thine own words: 14 Then shalt thou delight thyself in the LORD; and I will cause thee to ride upon the high places of the earth and feed thee with the heritage of Jacob thy father: for the mouth of the LORD hath spoken it. As God's new creation, we want to obey His law – Not because it is the law, but because we love Him.

Jeremiah 31:33 But this shall be the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel; After those days, saith the LORD, I will put my law in their inward parts, and write it in their hearts; and will be their God, and they shall be my people.

As prophesied by Jeremiah, speaking of latter days, and the, 'New Covenant,' when He will put His law in their hearts and in their inward parts. They shall be my people.

Ezekiel 20: **19** I am the LORD your God; walk in My statutes, keep My ordinances, and practice them. **20** Keep My Sabbaths holy, and they will be a sign between us, so that you may know that I am the LORD your God.” **21** But the children rebelled against Me. They did not walk in My statutes or carefully observe My ordinances—though the man who does these things will live by them—and they

profaned My Sabbaths. So I resolved to pour out My wrath upon them and vent My anger against them in the wilderness.... History repeats itself according to proverbs so we can expect to see again that those of the church who have forgotten His Sabbaths that were set to commemorate the 6 days of creation and His rest on the seventh day and therefore those who do not turn back will suffer His wrath.

The wrath of the great/tribulation is for those who have not believed and have gone off after false prophets and for Israel who rejected their Messiah.

1 Thessalonians 1:10 And to wait for his Son from heaven, whom he raised from the dead, *even* Jesus, which delivered us from the wrath to come.

We obey His laws, because through His grace, the laws are written on our hearts and in our inward parts, instead of on two tables of stone.

Leviticus 23:1-3 And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying, 2 Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, Concerning the feasts of the LORD, which ye shall proclaim to be holy convocations, even these are my feasts. 3 Six days shall work be done: but the seventh day is the sabbath of rest, an holy convocation; ye shall do no work therein: it is the sabbath of the LORD in all your dwellings.

Paul told us also to keep the true Sabbath and the 7 festivals which are the Lords appointed times with mankind.

1 Corinthians 5:8 Therefore let us keep the feast, not with old leaven, neither with the leaven of malice and

wickedness; but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth.

Hebrews 4:4 For he spake in a certain place of the seventh day on this wise, And God did rest the seventh day from all his works.

<sup>5</sup> And in this place again, If they shall enter into my rest.

<sup>6</sup> Seeing therefore it remaineth that some must enter therein, and they to whom it was first preached entered not in because of unbelief:

<sup>7</sup> Again, he limiteth a certain day, saying in David, To day, after so long a time; as it is said, To day if ye will hear his voice, harden not your hearts.

<sup>8</sup> For if Jesus had given them rest, then would he not afterward have spoken of another day.

<sup>9</sup> There remaineth therefore a rest to the people of God.

Paul is telling us that if there had been another day appointed Jesus would have told us so and He did not so we enter into the Sabbath rest as they did of old.

Both Yahshua and the Apostles kept the biblical sabbath and the Lords feasts. Paul instructed us to do the same. He pointed out that the sabbath day had not changed and he lived the sabbath observance himself all through his writings.

Hebrews 4:3 For we which have believed do enter into rest, as he said, As I have sworn in my wrath, if they shall enter

into my rest: although the works were finished from the foundation of the world.

Verse 10 For he that is entered into his rest, he also hath ceased from his own works, as God did from his. 11 Let us labour therefore to enter into that rest, lest any man fall after the same example of unbelief.

Yahshua said teach them all things you hear me say and see me do. If we are not following the law as Yashua did then we are not His at His coming.

Matthew 19:16-22

### **Yahshua Counsels the Rich Young Ruler.**

<sup>16</sup> Now behold, one came and said to Him, “Good<sup>[a]</sup> Teacher, what good thing shall I do that I may have eternal life?”

<sup>17</sup> So He said to him, <sup>[b]</sup>“Why do you call Me good? <sup>[c]</sup>No one *is* good but One, *that is*, God. But if you want to enter into life, keep the commandments.”

<sup>18</sup> He said to Him, “Which ones?”

Jesus said, “‘You shall not murder,’ ‘You shall not commit adultery,’ ‘You shall not steal,’ ‘You shall not bear false witness,’ <sup>19</sup> ‘Honor your father and *your* mother,’ and, ‘You shall love your neighbor as yourself.’ ”

<sup>20</sup> The young man said to Him, “All these things I have kept <sup>[d]</sup>from my youth. What do I still lack?”

<sup>21</sup> Jesus said to him, “If you want to be perfect, go, sell what you have and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven; and come, follow Me.”

<sup>22</sup> But when the young man heard that saying, he went away sorrowful, for he had great possessions.

Clearly here we see that Yashua names several of the 10 commandments. Now this is the perfect time for Him to tell the young man that there is no longer this law, but He did not and infact went into much detail to prove that they are very much still for all people.

Some will argue that was before the death and resurrection. So we will see what Paul said as he was the author of much of the New Testament after the cross.

Romans 7:12 Wherefore the law is holy, and the commandment holy, and just, and good.

Paul alternates between speaking of the law of sacrifice that was fulfilled by Yashua and between the law of the 10 commandments which he says are holy and good. His writings are clear in the fact that we must live the commandments and that without them we would not know sin.

We are released from the sacrificial law the law that was bondage to Israel. It was a works based law of sacrificial duties and rituals that were inadequate and involved full time priests whose duties were washings and anointing's and lighting fires for burnt offerings and sacrificing animals on the alter. It was a heavy burden for all who were under it and

now through the atoning one time for all sacrifice made by Yahshua we are free from the burden of the law. (Moses law written in a book for the sacrificial requirements and statutes of the law.)

Acts 24:14 But this I confess unto thee, that after the way which they call heresy, so worship I the God of my fathers, believing all things which are written in the law and in the prophets:

Paul clearly observed and believed in the 10 commandments and had a great reverence for the law.

Acts 25:8 While he answered for himself, Neither against the law of the Jews, neither against the temple, nor yet against Caesar, have I offended any-thing at all.

He states here that he has kept the law without any offence in any of it. He is speaking of the 10 commandments and we see throughout the church age he kept the Sabbath and observed it on the seventh day right throughout his ministry.

He kept the festivals with fervent obedience.

Acts 18:21 But bade them farewell, saying, I must by all means keep this feast that cometh in Jerusalem: but I will return again unto you, if God will. And he sailed from Ephesus.

Yahshua and all of the apostles kept the commandments, including the seventh day Sabbath and the 7 festivals of the Lord throughout the entirety of the new covenant.

We are instructed to keep the laws and feasts and there is no variance from any of it.

Those who ignore this will find themselves called lawless and there is no place in Gods kingdom for the lawless.

Matthew 7:21-23

I Never Knew You

<sup>21</sup> “Not everyone who says to Me, ‘Lord, Lord,’ shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father in heaven. <sup>22</sup> Many will say to Me in that day, ‘Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in Your name, cast out demons in Your name, and done many wonders in Your name?’ <sup>23</sup> And then I will declare to them, ‘I never knew you; depart from Me, you who practice lawlessness!’

In the book of Revelation it is the saints who have kept the commandments of God who are saved in His kingdom.

Revelation 14:12 Here is the patience of the saints: here *are* they that keep the commandments of God, and the faith of Jesus.

**James 2:9-13**

**<sup>9</sup> But if ye have respect to persons, ye commit sin, and are convinced of the law as transgressors. <sup>10</sup> For whosoever shall keep the whole law, and yet offend in one point, he is guilty of all. <sup>11</sup> For he that said, Do not commit adultery, said also, Do not kill. Now if thou commit no adultery, yet if thou kill, thou art become a transgressor of the law.**

**<sup>12</sup> So speak ye, and so do, as they that shall be judged by the law of liberty.**

**Paul calls it the law of liberty. Its sets us free from sin.**

**We are not Levitical priests but are now a royal priesthood under the law of Yahshua Ha Mashiach.**

1 Peter 2:9 (KJV) <sup>9</sup>But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvelous light;

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
